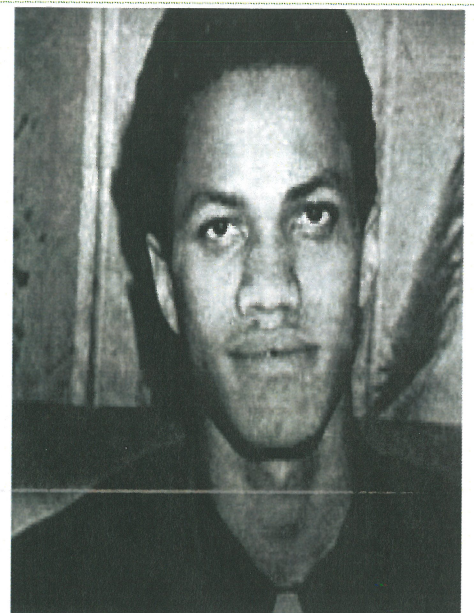
In the end of this section King and the people of Alabama start a protest and boycott. King also has another child but is later arrested once more for violating the law.
